First Announcement

The 4th Exam for awarding the **European Diploma in Transplant Medicine** is organised by the European Board of Transplant Medicine of the Division of Transplantation of the UEMS in collaboration with the European Society of Organ Transplantation (ESOT).

**Application starts March 15th, 2017 and is opened for both
Junior and Senior transplant physicians**

Junior candidates

Junior transplant physicians should have a minimal 2-year training in transplantation medicine for applying. Juniors should apply for the Common Transplantation Medicine Module together with one or more of the Organ Modules: Kidney, Pancreas, Heart, Lung, Liver and Intestinal/Multivisceral Transplantation.

Deadline for application is **June 15th, 2017**

Final examination of eligible candidates will take place in Barcelona on **23rd September 2017**, the day before ESOT meeting.

Senior candidates

Senior transplant physicians with at least 10 years of continuous experience as specialists practicing in formal nationally recognized posts are eligible to apply for an Honorary Diploma and be exempted of the examination.

Seniors can apply for the following modules: Kidney, Pancreas, Heart, Lung, Liver and Intestinal/Multivisceral Transplantation.

For Honorary Diploma, **Deadline for application is 15th June 2017**
